

CAMZYOS® (mavacamten) PATIENT CARD



Patient instructions: Carry this card with you **at all times**. Tell any healthcare professional who sees you that you are taking CAMZYOS.

This card, format and content have been approved by the IMOH in May 2024

CAMZYOS is indicated for the treatment of adults with symptomatic New York Heart Association (NYHA) class II-III obstructive hypertrophic cardiomyopathy (HCM) with mild to significant symptoms during daily activity, to improve symptoms and functional capacity.

Safety information for patients of childbearing potential:

- If you are pregnant or plan to become pregnant, consult your doctor before starting treatment with CAMZYOS.
- CAMZYOS may harm your unborn baby if used during pregnancy.
- If you are able to get pregnant, you should use an effective method of contraception throughout treatment with CAMZYOS and for 4 months after your last dose of CAMZYOS. CAMZYOS may reduce how well hormonal birth control works. You should discuss with your doctor which method(s) of contraception is/are the most suitable for you.
- Talk to your doctor if you are considering becoming pregnant.
- If you suspect that you may be pregnant or are pregnant, you must inform your prescriber or doctor **immediately**.

Safety information for all patients:

- Tell your prescriber or doctor or seek other medical attention **immediately** if you experience new or worsening symptoms of heart failure, including shortness of breath, chest pain, fatigue, swelling in your legs, a racing sensation in your heart (palpitations), or rapid weight gain.
- Tell your prescriber or doctor of any new or existing medical conditions.
- Tell your prescriber, doctor or pharmacist before starting new medicines (including prescription and those available over the counter), vitamins or herbal supplements. **Do not** stop taking or change the dose of any medicine or herbal supplement that you are already taking without consulting with your doctor or pharmacist first, as other medicines can affect how well CAMZYOS works.
- Tell any healthcare professional who sees you if any side effects occur while you are taking CAMZYOS.
- Remember to keep all appointments, especially echocardiogram (also known as echo) appointments, to monitor your heart's health.
